Chief Turbeville noted that the grass is dry and there may be more power shut offs this year. He reviewed the burn permit process and the changes beginning May 1. If your pile is bigger than 4 x 4 you need Cal Fire to inspect it unless you are on the valley floor, which only requires an air quality permit.

The Asti summer crossing will most likely go up in 1 -2 weeks.
