- b. Pledge of Allegiance
- c. Roll Call: Directors Rob Stewart, Larry Heiges, and Fred Peterson were present. Fire Chief Marshall Turbeville and Administrative Manager Anneke Turbeville were also present. Rob Stewart had to leave the meeting at 1:55 PM after Item #5.
